

Point-In-Time Count

Central West Virginia

(Kanawha, Clay, Boone, Putnam Counties)

January 28, 2010

The Point-In-Time Count identified 429 homeless people, in four counties (Kanawha, Clay, Boone and Putnam) on January 28, 2010. Of the 429 people located, 248 were men, 114 were women, 66 were children, and 1 persons gender was unknown.

The data was collected at service agencies, soup kitchens, shelters, churches and in public places, and was collected via provider data and client level data. General data was collected on those who chose not to participate in the surveyed.

At the conclusion of the count, 23 duplicate surveys were discarded as were 43 surveys that did not conform to the required definition of homelessness (example: staying with a friend).

It should also be noted that some agencies chose not to participate in the Point-In-Time Count; therefore, reasonable prudence would suggest that there are more homeless people than the 429 identified.

The following charts and attached graphs demonstrate the actual numbers and comparative data on the homeless people identified. However, the following does not include comparative data on the 7 subpopulations because the results were inconsistently collected, and therefore, would not lead to a meaningful conclusion. The totaled subpopulation data is attached.

Of the 363 sheltered and unsheltered **ADULTS** located, 66.85% were men, 32.88% were women, and 0.27% unknown.
